In every aspect of the decision-making process, the management makes every effort to maintain a significant degree of independence from the institution.

1. For the administration and academic departments to run smoothly and effectively, the college delegated tasks to a number of committees.
2. The foundation of the institution is the Examination Department. This committee's main responsibility is to carry out the examination and evaluation process. There are enough employees to support the examination procedure. In essence, this committee handles a number of tasks, including the appointment of paper-setters, examiners, moderators, proof-readers, and assessors, among others. The rules and regulations established by JNTU, Kakinada, must be adhered to by the examination committee.
3. According to the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India and the University Grants Commission's (UGC) concerned announcement, the college has an anti-ragging committee that operates. 7. The Student Welfare Department offers students a variety of welfare programs. The department helps students become productive members of society by offering them leadership, social, extracurricular, counseling, and financial support.
8. The purpose of the Committee of Staff Welfare is to protect the wellbeing of the college's faculty. The general staff's welfare and well-being are the focus of this committee, which also serves as a conduit for communication.
